#### Ordinances

2023 - Recap Last year was busy in Lansing, with more than 300 laws passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor, including the repeal of Right to Work and the passage of a tax cut and economic development package that will both reduce retiree taxes and earmark \$500 million each year (for 3 years) in corporate income tax specifically for large scale economic development projects in the state.

24- Public Safety Millage - Last week, the Jackson County Commission approved language to appear on the August ballot. The proposal, at .90 mills for 20 years (~\$45 per \$100,000 market value), would provide a stable funding source for the construction, financing and operations of an addition to the Chanter Road jail facility. This fiscally sound proposal is the result of a year old Wesley Street facility is too costly for repair and would provide improved conditions public safety officers and those in their care.

24 - Minimum Wage - On Jan. 1, 2024, MI's minimum wage rose from \$10.10 to \$10.33 per hour.

The rise is a result of the **2018 law** that raises the minimum wage each year through 2030, when the minimum wage under the law will be \$12.05. This 2018 law replaced a ballot increased the hourly minimum wage to \$12.00 by 2022, followed by annual increases tied to inflation.
