Ordinances

Opposition to HB 4237 and SB 171, which would grant more than 1,800 local units of government the<br/>ability to adopt their own, individual rules and regulations to govern labor relations. These<br/>especially impact small businesses that may not have resources to comply with a<br/>of regulations. It remains important for both employers and employees to<br/>leave time and benefits.

Joined the coalition to oppose the creation of a one-size-fits-all state administered <u>paid leave</u> insurance program. This program would raise taxes on employers and many employees, creating costly on both businesses and the people they employ.

Joined dozens of chambers and associations to oppose HB 4390, a bill to limit the ability of employers to use independent contractors. While other states with similar laws have created exceptions for workers (California has 109), this legislation contains no exceptions, and penalties for employee misclassification could lead to prison sentences for repeat offenses.
